







Supportive Recovery Program

-  **The Supportive Recovery program creates a safe, supportive environment for youth affected by substance use.**
-  **The program works with youth to reduce harm by supporting them to make positive changes around their substance use.**
-  **This is a voluntary, short-term program for youth aged 13-19.**
-  **Youth are placed in one of our supportive Contracted Care Family homes which are situated throughout Greater Victoria.**
-  **We believe that youth should live with their families whenever possible and our program encourages family reunification. When this is not possible we assist youth in exploring alternatives while maintaining a connection with their families.**
-  **Parents remain the legal guardian while the youth resides in the program.**

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Supportive Recovery Program

Care Families provide youth with their basic needs including: food, shelter and basic toiletries.

Each youth is assigned an individual support worker who will provide:

- Confidential, respectful, participant-directed services for youth and their families**
- Programming that explores participant choices, models healthy communication and builds healthy relationships, life skills and much more**
- Support in accessing a variety of community resources including Discovery substance use counselling, education, employment, mental health and other services as needed**

Parents may be encouraged to attend Boys & Girls Clubs' parenting programs and participate in family counselling.
