The Youth Justice Transition Program (YJTP) provides 24-hour support to you and helps you make plans for school, program attendance and transition, including:

-  Education
-  Employment
-  Health
-  Housing

Each safe and supportive Care Family home in the community will host only one youth while they are in the program.

You will receive follow-up support to help you stay on track after transition.
