The EDGE Program is a voluntary 4-month full-time attendance program that you can participate in to follow the conditions of your Probation Order while developing your own goals for positive Experience, Direction, Growth, and Education in your life.

Our program places you in a safe and supportive Care Family home and assigns you a Primary Youth Counsellor you will assist you in achieving your goals.

You will participate in structured group programming Monday to Friday between 9am and 3pm, as well as evening activities with program staff.

The program includes participation in:

- School program
- Daily physical activity
- Life skills development
- Individual and group counseling
- Career preparation and skill development
